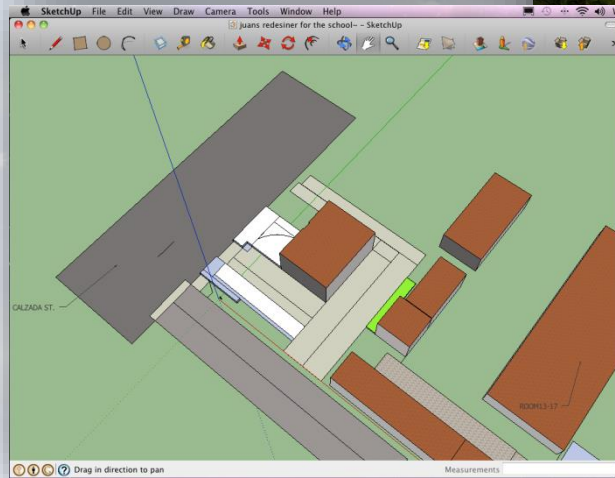

- Jan Sprague's students at Mary Buren Elementary in Guadalupe save energy and recycle water bottles.

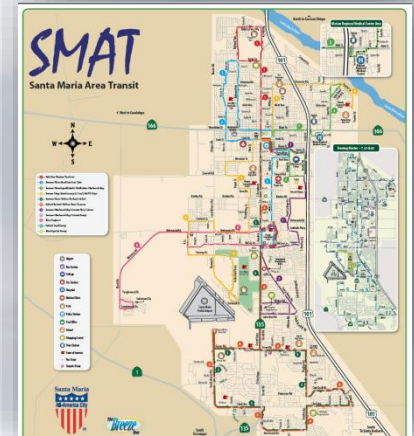
