Terry Dressler, APCO, gave a brief report regarding air quality in Santa Barbara County and noted it has been the cleanest year on record. We have exceeded the state eight-hour standard for ozone only 7 days, all of which occurred in September, and mainly during the hot spell weather September 24-29. In comparison, in 2008 we had 12 exceedances of the state eight-hour ozone standard and in 2009 we had 10 days of ozone exceedances.
