SUBJECT: District Hearing Board Appointment

RECOMMENDATION:

Consider recommendation of the District Hearing Board Nominating Committee to reappoint Mr. Terence Dressler to the public member position on the District Hearing Board for a 3-year term.

DISCUSSION:

The District Hearing Board Nominating Committee (Committee) met on May 18, 2023 to consider options for filling the expiring term of Mr. Terence Dressler, a public member representative on the District Hearing Board and receive an update on recruitment efforts for the upcoming vacant engineer position. Present were committee members Paula Perotte, Joan Hartmann, and Bob Nelson. Committee members Das Williams and Alice Patino were absent.

Mr. Terence Dressler has been serving as a public member representative on the Hearing Board since June 2017. His current term is set to expire August 2023. Should the Board wish to extend his term, Mr. Dressler has expressed interest in continuing his position on the Hearing Board.

After consideration, the committee members present unanimously voted to recommend that the District Board of Directors reappoint Mr. Terence Dressler to the public member position on the District Hearing Board for a three-year term.
