SUBJECT: July 8 CAC Meeting to Introduce the 2025 Ozone Plan

Every three years, the District is required to update our plan to attain and maintain the state 1-hour and 8-hour ozone standards. The 2025 Ozone Plan will be the eleventh triennial update to the initial state Air Quality Attainment Plan adopted by the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District (District) Board of Directors in 1991. We anticipate that the 2025 Ozone Plan will be composed of seven chapters that address air quality trends, the emission inventory, stationary source control measures, transportation control measures, voluntary incentive programs, and the attainment strategy.

District staff will introduce a high-level overview 2025 Ozone Plan at the July 8, 2024, Community Advisory Council meeting. This agenda item will be informational only (i.e., no formal CAC recommendation will be sought).

District staff plans to hold the next CAC meeting early next year to begin the review process and discuss the 2025 Ozone Plan. District staff intend to take the 2025 Ozone Plan to the District Board for a public hearing and adoption in the fall of 2025.
